Free from fever for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medication (e.g. Tylenol, Motrin).	Free from vomiting for at least 24 hours or until cleared by a medical provider.	Free from diarrhea for at least 24 hours or until cleared by a medical provider.	Completed recommended treatment and no evidence of new live lice.	Cleared for return with documentation from a medical provider, after taking antibiotics for 24 hours, or until symptoms have resolved.
